

New Developments Happening in Lembah Pantai (next to Pantai Sentral Park)



(9 September 2016) Patrons to our Gasing Indahshops near Maxwell Towers may have noted a new signboard announcing further development plans for Sanctuary Ridge. The signboard indicates that low-density (19 persons to an acre) bungalows/villas (normal and strata) are under consideration. This would make this development among the lowest density neighbourhoods in the entire Bukit Gasing area. By comparison, nearby Taman Gasing Indah accommodates 48 persons per acre; and Gasing Heights Condominiums has a population of 160 persons per acre; and Pantai Sentral Park's density would likely be several hundred persons per acre based on available information.

It appears that interest is increasing in this area of Lembah Pantai which falls within the Transit Planning Zone under Kuala Lumpur's City Plan 2020: the nearest commuter station is only 600m away and is accessible on foot within 10-15 minutes. It would be good if more people used our public transport system as that would ease congestion on the roads for all citizens!
